**SAT: November 2,, 2017** registration deadline, test date **December 2, 2017**

- Register early to secure a spot at a local testing site.

**ACT: November 3, 2017** registration deadline, test date **December 9th, 2017**

**Send four score reports while they're free.** Sending to CSU Mentor (**use code 3594**) will cover ALL 23 CSU's. This will allow all 23 CSU campuses to receive your ACT scores. In addition, if you send your ACT scores to one UC school, all UC schools will be able to access the score.

Use your other free score-sends for private colleges or NCAA (code 9999) or NAIA (9876).

You are invited to attend the Teen Court volunteer training on Jan. 20, 2018 from 6 to 8pm at the El Dorado County Superior Court, 495 Main St. in Placerville.

After completing the mandatory training, teens serve as court personnel for real cases in which a minor has committed an offense, admitted the offense and chosen to be judge for sentencing by their peers. Students will serve in roles such as juror, prosecuting and defense attorney, court clerk and bailiff. Interested?
