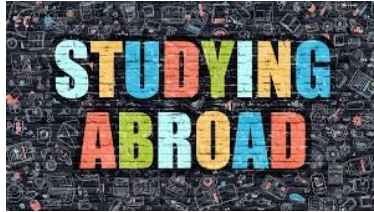
You can pay any fees and order official transcripts on-line through e-Services. If you need help go to your Career Center.

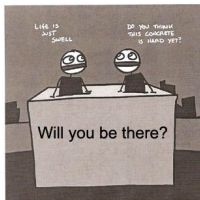

Send **four** score reports while they're free. College Board and ACT cover the cost of sending scores to four institutions within nine days of taking the exam, after that there is a fee. Review [here!](#)

Sending to CSU Mentor (**use code 3594**) will cover ALL 23 CSU's. This will allow all 23 CSU campuses to receive your ACT scores. In addition, if you send your ACT scores to one UC school, all UC schools will be able to access the score.
