Juniors and Seniors: If you are going to a 4-year college please register to take the SAT and ACT tests. **VA School Code (CEEB 050856)** Check [here](#) for locations. Click [here](#) for 2019-2020 test dates!

Send **four** score reports while they're free. College Board and ACT cover the cost of sending scores to **four institutions within nine days of taking the exam, after that, there is a fee.** Review [here!](#)

How many times should you take the SAT or the ACT?

You are allowed to take the ACT up to 12 times. You're limited by time and test dates they offer. Click [here](#) to read more for the SAT.

Sending to CSU Mentor (**use code 3594**) will cover **ALL 23 CSU's**. This will allow all 23 CSU campuses to receive your ACT scores. In addition, if you send your ACT scores to one UC school, all UC schools will be able to access the score.

***Use your other free score-sends for private colleges or NCAA (code 9999) or NAIA (9876).**
